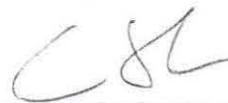

We the undersigned Board of Appraisers of The Miami Conservancy District, a body corporate and a political subdivision of the State of Ohio, duly appointed by the Court of Common Pleas of Montgomery County, Ohio, in Case No. 36847, have, in accordance with Section 6101.54 of the Revised Code of Ohio and the Entry Ordering The Miami Conservancy District's Board of appraisers to Conduct a Readjustment of the Appraisal of Benefits filed August 26, 2020, approved a Revised Appraisal Record of Benefits readjusting the appraisal of benefits to properties and public corporations resulting from the flood protection works of The Miami Conservancy District, to provide a basis upon which to levy the maintenance assessment under Section 6101.53 of the Revised Code of Ohio and a capital improvement assessment under Section 6101.48 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

We do hereby certify that the within is a correct record of the appraisal of benefits as readjusted by the Board of Appraisers with respect to such properties and public corporations.

The designations given on the Revised Appraisal Record of Benefits include the following:

PARCEL ID – The County Auditor's parcel identification number for each property.

ADDRESS – The tax address or other known address if ascertainable.

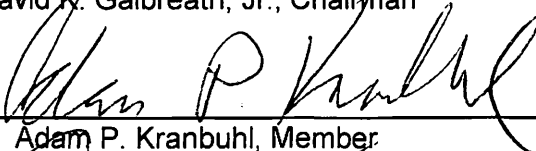
BENEFIT – The readjusted benefit as determined by the Board of Appraisers for each individual property or public corporation.

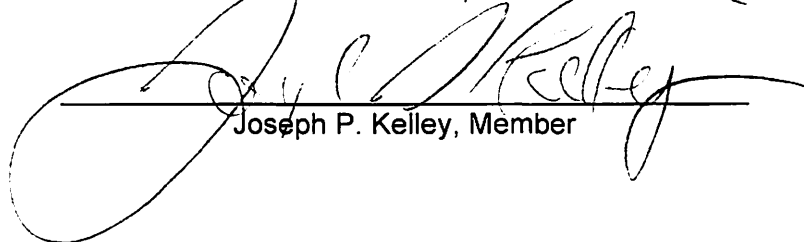
